

JINNAH MEDICAL COLLEGE PESHAWAR ADMISSION POLICY FOR MBBS SESSION 2023-24

The following admission policy is formulated for the admission of students to 1st Professional MBBS, session 2023-24. The policy is in compliance with the provisions of Pakistan Medical and Dental Council (PM&DC) *Medical* & Dental Undergraduate Education (Admission, Curriculum and Conduct) Policy & Regulations 2023, dated 13th July, 2023.

<u>Aim:</u> To lay down the procedure for transparent, fair, and merit-based selection of students for the 1st Professional MBBS as required under the PM&DC Admission Regulations.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 1. Any candidate seeking admission in MBBS program shall be eligible having fulfilled the following mandatory criteria:
- 2. Have passed, the MDCAT examination, conducted by the National Medical Authority, as determined by PM&DC.
- Obtained a HSSC or an equivalent 12th grade qualification recognized in Pakistan with more than 60% marks or higher grade.
- Passed the subjects of Biology and Chemistry and either Physics or Mathematics in the examination of HSSC or an equivalent 12th grade qualification recognized in Pakistan.

Eligible candidates are required to meet the following criteria for admission into the MBBS program: Merit formula (as per PM&DC) is as under:

a. SSC 10%

b. HSSC or Equivalent 40%

. MDCAT 50%

ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

The admission will be based on merit as per the above criteria in line with PM&DC regulations as under:

- 1. The admission process will be conducted through online portal of Jinnah Medical College.
- After having completed the results of MDCAT and other exam results for the purpose of calculating merit, the College will publish a merit list on its website with a copy to PM&DC. Merit-based conditional admission will be offered to students.
- Applicants will have at least three working days to submit their fee, which will serve as the student's acceptance of the offer.
- 4. After payment of the fee, if there is any vacant seat, the next student on the waiting list will be offered admission to
- 5. The College will complete its admissions of 100 seats by or before January 15th, 2024.
- The final list of admitted students shall be submitted to PM&DC online by or before January 30th.
- 7. As per PM&DC guidelines, the fee structure for the entire five years will be uploaded on the website.
- 8. Each year, the students must pay the fee timely or they will be liable for a fine of 5% of the total fee.
- 9. Fee concession will be as per PM&DC regulations.
- 10. Limited number of merit scholarships is available as per policy.
- 11. Hostel accommodation will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 12. It is the responsibility of all applicants to visit the website www.jmcp.edu.pk
- 13. All the selected applicants and their parents or guardians will be required to submit an affidavit on a Rs. 100 stamp paper duly notarized by a notary stating their acceptance of Jinnah Medical College's required disciplinary, legal,

and financial responsibilities and all other rules and regulations specified in the college prospectus. A specimen of the affidavit will be provided by the college.

14. The admission offer will remain conditional, subject to verification of documents and deposit within the stipulated period.

HEALTH SCREENING:

Every student accepted into the MBBS program will undergo the following screenings, prior to receiving their class numbers:

- 1. Full blood count to check for anemia and other hematological disorders.
- 2. Chest X-Ray to check for tuberculosis.
- 3. Hepatitis B, C, and HIV screen.
- 4. Blood and urine sugar to check for diabetes.
- 5. Moreover, all students must have COVID-19 and Hepatitis B vaccination.

GENEARAL PROVISIONS:

- PM&DC directives regarding admission issued from time to time will be followed. A strict no donation policy is adopted.
- 2. Definition of Foreign Student and Pakistani Student

According to the Medical and Dental Undergraduate Education (Admissions, Curriculum, and Conduct) Regulations 2022, foreign and Pakistani students are defined, and the regulations for their fees are clearly stated as:

- a) "Foreign Student" means a student who is not a Pakistani student and holds only a Foreign Nationality.
- b) "Pakistani student" means a student who is a Pakistani national or defined as an overseas Pakistani under applicable law, may hold dual nationality, and may be resident or non-resident in Pakistan.
- c) Notwithstanding scholarships granted to a student, the College will charge the same fee to all Pakistani students. The College may charge a higher fee for a foreign
